Planning for the November General and Special Elections and having Voting Machine L&N testing conducted.



Business:


1. It was moved seconded and approved to send a letter of acknowledgement of service for more than 15 years as an election official in Greene County to William "Bill" Steo.


ESO will be conducting L&A Testing of OVI and OVO voting machines at 1 P.M. this afternoon.
