

MINUTES: Greene County Electoral Board
Meeting June 7, 2022

The Greene County Electoral Board met on **June 7, 2022** at the General Registrar's office in Stanardsville, VA. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Deborah Turck at 3:05 p.m.

Agenda presented by the General Registrar was presented and approved for the meeting.

The Board approved the minutes as amended.

Agenda Items:

Registrar's report: The Registrar is working with the vendor to continue setting up new pollbooks and to produce user manuals for election day. She is also completing preparation of all supplies for precinct use on election day. Early voting proceeds with an average of five or fewer voters per day.

Election Day: The Board and Registrar reviewed administrative issues regarding final arrangements for June 21 primary election, including VDOT permission for placement of signs directing voters to new site at Holiday Inn on 29, placement of other signs at temporary precinct locations, official delivery of voting equipment to precinct sites by the Electoral Board, and publicity regarding alternate precinct sites for the June 21 primary.

Legal: The Electoral Board interpreted and clarified a Code of Virginia question regarding the number of vote count observers allowed at a precinct, as allowed by election law in Section 24.2-655 of the Code.

The Electoral Board of Greene County moved, seconded, voted, and ruled that the number of observers will be two officially endorsed observers for each political party, one for each independent, and one for each candidate in a primary. In the case of observer spaces available because these were not filled, the precinct may select bystanders to fill those spaces. Observers will total no more than the total number of spaces allowed per election in any precinct.

The Board also clarified that potential bystander observers should notify the Chief of Precinct that they wish to observe if space is available prior to the closing of the polls.

Officer of Election Training: The Board reviewed materials for the Officers of Election training prepared by the General Registrar. The materials must be condensed because of the time

that must be devoted to training for use of the new pollbooks and clarifying changes in voting locations.


There being no further business, the Chair adjourned the meeting at 5:00 p.m.
